Social Justice Innovation Awards: Support program outreach, application and selection, and engagement with nominators, applicants, reviewers, and fellows.

Digital Advancement Institute: Support data and policy-related projects including partner engagement, policy analysis; development of education and training content; drafting of statements, briefings, and reports; and developing digital content.

Digital Integrators: Support the development and implementation of a national program focused on connecting residents and communities to digital skills for workforce development.

As the Resource Development Analyst, you will report to the foundation's president. Your day-to-day duties will require you to work closely with CTF staff and partners. You will play a key role in supporting fundraising projects, including CRM, donor engagement, prospect research, proposal development, project management, marketing and communications, while also contributing to the broader goals and priorities of the Centri Tech Foundation.
